- Provide assistance in researching and understanding inconsistencies and discrepancies in valuation models/reports.
- Continuously monitor and maintain a consistent view of portfolio companies' financials/valuation
- Respond to ad hoc requests from other departments as well as from management
- Assist in gathering quarterly market research.

- Excellent academic credentials, university degree in finance/valuation or equivalent qualification with a minimum of five years' experience preferably with alternative investments, Luxembourg GAAP and IFRS
